IN THE City FOR A Global Community

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The Indianapolis Children's Choir has launched a capital campaign called *In the City for A Global Community* so that we can secure funding for our new building at 9111 Allisonville Road in Indianapolis that allows us to meet our **long-term artistic goals** and **serve the central Indiana community** while making a global impact. This new building will give us the necessary **space to expand our programming** to more children and families. All of these efforts will **support our continued financial stability**.

Establishing our own home will enable the ICC to have an impact on central Indiana as a cultural institution that has an even greater impact on the global choral community. A new headquarters will enable the ICC to establish an Arts Center that will facilitate creating artistic excellence in new ways. For example, the ICC will be able to bring in partner organizations from the Indianapolis area, across the country, and around the world to use state-of-the-art facilities that leverage technology to enhance the experience of singers and educators.

The *In the City for A Global Community* capital campaign is an opportunity for individuals, organizations, and corporate partners to invest in the future of the ICC and to share in its mission and vision. Gifts to the campaign will ensure that the ICC is positioned for sustained long-term growth and sustainability as a leader in choral music globally. The arts are essential to the health and vitality of neighborhoods, cities, states, and our nation. They enhance community development, create jobs, spur urban renewal, attract new businesses, draw tourism dollars, and create an environment that attracts skilled and educated workers. Support for the arts is an investment in the economic well-being and quality of life of our community. Nationally as well as locally, the arts mean business – the impact of the ICC on the Indianapolis economy is \$3.5 million (Arts for Education).

The ICC is conducting a capital campaign with the **goal of raising \$4 million** to purchase and renovate a new headquarters for the ICC to ensure long-term financial and artistic sustainability for our singers and families, the city of Indianapolis and surrounding area, and the global choral community.





Throughout our 37-year history, the ICC has been at the forefront of music education, with a reputation of leadership not just in Indiana, but across the country and around the globe. The ICC's artistic staff has placed a premium on listening to the needs of the community and then gearing programming to meet those needs. We are committed to continuing this work as we move forward, and with the help of donors, the future potential of the ICC is incredibly exciting. The ICC has spent 37 years building an incredible music education and performing arts organization that benefits both singers and our community. The ICC's New Headquarters

In December 2022, the ICC had raised enough funds to secure a bank line of credit to purchase the building at 9111 Allisonville Road in Indianapolis. It was the generosity of several major donors that helped the ICC to be able to move forward with the down payment to purchase the building after searching for a new space for nearly two years.

The two-story headquarters is double the size of our current facilities. The building, once renovated for our choral programs, will provide the long-term sustainability and opportunities for innovation to be able chart our own course for the future. The building will include the ICC offices, rehearsal spaces, classrooms, a music library, collaborative spaces for other arts partners, a conference center, and free parking for guests and families.

This new headquarters will serve as an Arts Center to increase our capacity to serve even more children and families each year. Together, we can invest in ICC singers and our community while making a global impact.
